We are heading into November and it is clear that Lakeview is an active, dynamic and positive place for learning! The teaching and support staff are working so hard to provide students with a quality educational program each day.

November brings lots of activities such as after school skating, volleyball for our grade 5 students, and numerous field trips. Teachers are regularly assessing (gathering information) and evaluating (making judgments on products and activities) student progress and formal report cards are (summative) snapshots of lessons and units over a period of time. Report cards are formal communications of students' achievement in relation to curricular expectations and provincial learning outcomes. Regular and continued communication between the home and school is important in supporting student learning and achievement.
