- Covid Update = Lakeview is being very stringent on the rules for Covid in the school as there has been lots of Covid Cases in the School district recently.
- Registrations = Ongoing;  
Out of Bounds Registration Form needs to be submitted by March 23 – After those are received then the Returning Registration Forms will next;  
Lakeview Kindergarten Numbers are at 30 so far, a week into registration  
For the First time at Lakeview, Early Education Program will be run at the school
- Staffing =

Number of Students will affect Staffing Numbers – hoping to have Teachers assigned after Easter & then Support Staff will be after that, around June
