As far as safety is concerned, you may be aware that the decision was made at the Provincial level to move all students from grade 7-12 to learning online. We are in the middle of an extremely concerning time of this pandemic. Please continue to help us keep our school open by :

1. Making sure your child is healthy each morning before you send them to school. If your child comes to school not feeling well and then tests positive for COVID-19, that means their entire class and teaching staff will be out for quarantine. We know it's challenging to keep children home, but it's our first line of defense for a healthy school.

2. Please make sure your child comes to school with a mask. We are happy to provide one if your child doesn't have one, but it helps to have them arrive and be greeted when wearing a mask.

3. If your child rides the bus, please remind them and enforce the expectation that masks are always worn on the bus. We have constant reports from Southland that students aren't wearing their masks. From the school building we can only enforce this after the ride is done. A student who may not be showing symptoms and is riding the bus with students from kindergarten to grade 5 can infect multiple classes and staff. Please reinforce this with your child or drive them yourself if they can't comply with this.

We all thank you for helping us keep our school open so we can teach and be with your amazing kiddos! It's tough now but I know it will get better if we can hang in there and follow the guidelines.
