SafeArrival

Starting Monday, November 1, 2021, you may report absences in advance using SafeArrival. Also, starting Monday, November 1, 2021 staff will be using the SafeArrival notifications to let you know if your student is absent (when you haven't reported the absence in advance).

When using **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

1. **SchoolMessenger app** from the Apple App store or Google Play store
2. Use the **SafeArrival website**, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>
3. Call the toll-free number **866-879-1041** to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.
