Hopeful to have three kindergarten classrooms. Open to accept out of bounds children if possible. • Field Trips. We are currently going ahead with some virtual field trips. And hope to move ahead with physical field trips as the temperatures warm up and students can be outside. • BOOST (extra funding from Alberta Education to support learning disruptions caused by COVID) – have received funding to support a half time teacher to help grade 2/3 students.
