Due to enrollment, there is a possibility for a grade 1 and 2 split class. ○ Advertised for a Grade 5 teacher position that was posted today. ○ Lakeview will have a full-time counsellor next year. ○ Staggered entry throughout first week of school. ● Field Trips are back on. Fundraising helps to supplement field trip fees, as busing costs have increased dramatically. ● Assemblies started back three weeks ago. ● Grade 5 team is planning Grade 5 Farewell. We will be hosting Plaxton Grade 5's. ● Walking curriculum – great way of moving our bodies and connecting with the students. Five teachers have committed to incorporating that into their schedules. ● Mud kitchen will be up until next Wednesday. Water station will be scheduled for when the weather is hot. ● Outdoor Learning Day coming at the end of May. ● Sport's Day is scheduled for June 24 and lots of parent volunteers will be needed.
