Build self-regulation, problem solve, and build emotional/social strategies. It was discussed that this may not be best for all Lakeview Students at this time. ○ IDEA from Candice - Large Cookies (\$1/piece) with a juice box – maybe \$3 a piece – should be a small margin of profit for fundraising. ○ Special Delivery can mean so many different things – can be a cookie, or skipping rope, or a box of side walk chalk. Just something special for the kids to look forward to. ○ Connie stated that in the past Parent Council has had Kona Ice come for all children in the past. Alternating between “Special Delivery Day” that is paid by students and one that is offered for school. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plan to have first SPECIAL DELIVERY DAY for April. ○ The idea is to create a more inclusive experience for all students. ○ Stacey stated that having more funds coming in would be beneficial to the budget. Stated that she was hoping to have another popcorn fundraiser in the spring (tentatively APRIL – use April break for children to talk to their families). Connie feels confident that we will be allowed to have parents sorting popcorn with masks in the gym. ○ Stacey asked about shifting these meetings in person with changing restrictions. Connie stated that things are moving quickly, and we will have more answers March 1. ○ March 7 – Oki (oh-kee) hello/welcome in Blackfoot. The OKI sign will be at Lakeview on March 7.
