Under \$9,000 coming from school council bank account closing and \$9,800 in current account.</li> <li>- For upcoming meetings there will be a print out of transactions that is shared each month to be kept track of in the minutes.</li> <li>- Currently the school is doing the Kernels popcorn fundraising to raise money for field trips</li> <li>- Motion to approve budget by Candice. All in favour</li> </ul>

Students were incredibly respectful.
