Lakeview's growth observed in students' citizenship skills is encouraging and reflects the success of efforts to instill a sense of responsibility and community engagement. By building on these achievements, we can continue to mold students into conscientious, socially aware, and ethically responsible individuals who positively contribute to their communities and broader society. Some of the strategies our school is implementing to educate students in the are of citizenship include:

- School wide social emotional learning program, Second Step, taught by our teacher counsellor and student support worker
- Intentionally designed spaces to promote the practice of self regulation in an authentic way (WIN room, play commons, creative commons, reading room)
- Increased time to learn/play outside
- Monthly outdoor school wide assemblies
- Weekly wellness blocks for all students where students are able to experiment with a wide range of activities
- Soft start to each day where every student has an opportunity to engage with an adult before the day begins
- A variety of extra curricular activities including volleyball, basketball, handbells, choir and running club
- Leadership opportunities such as environmental stewardship, partnerships with a care home for seniors, and caring for our community through activities like food drives

Evaluation

Lakeview is committed to ensuring parents are involved in the decision making of their child's education. While these results are acceptable, there is room for improvement. Some of the strategies we are implementing to address this area include:

- Provide opportunities for parents to visit the school as a family: Meet the staff and popsicles in the park event, winter festival, celebration of learning, literacy/numeracy events
- Provide opportunities for parents to attend special classroom events and field trips
- Provide opportunities for parents to attend evening learning sessions (i.e session with Dr. Chris Mattatall on Learning and the Brain)
- Increase communication between the classroom and home
- Maintain school social media accounts and regularly share information through email and newsletters
- Increase parent involvement through school council initiatives—establishing committees for parents to be involved in school activities in addition to attending meetings, and community building initiatives
- Provide opportunities for parents to become involved in volunteering in the school (i.e popcorn fundraiser)
- Monthly school wide assemblies
