Grade Four parents they will be receiving an Assurance Plan Survey in the mail and students will do it here at school, typically low turnout so we would like to have as many people participate as possible The wording on occasion can be confusing for parents, Connie sends out vernacular terms or answers beforehand

"I don't know" counts as a "no" - so we would like to help give parents the tools to answer the questions

Kindergarten Registration started on Monday, let parents know who live in boundary – early registration gives a good idea of how we can prepare

Dividing the classes in September is challenging, so the earlier the better Lots of registrations already

Celebration of Learning is coming up in March

There will be celebrating learning and students will be leading parents through what they're doing in class, be able to get a good understanding of where parents are at

Staff – Lakeview received BOOST .45 teacher, science to grade 3 and will switch to grade 2 Gives our grade 3 teachers a thirty minute intervention block

Kathleen Schell – now until the end of June

Grade 5 was divided into three groups, we were monitoring grade 5 all fall and then in December we kept getting new enrollments and it coincided with the time the gov't gave supported growth Our Grade 5 teacher who was half time and now full time

Kids review is not to be so crowded in classrooms

We had planned the year with the possibility of this happening so we the transition is seamless It's good because they know each other well and kids are still able to be together

Our learning support teacher has moved to the ED center filling in for a leave, we have someone filling in for him – Rebecca Divine

We had a winter contest, Dress for the Weather – catching kids wearing great winter clothing Basketball in full swing – Candice and Stacey are volunteers, thank you for that

You never know the challenge when we start with a new team, as they start to play sports and the focus really is on fun
